Before you swap your boots for flip-flops, you'll need to complete your 120 Hour Online TEFL Course, which is included in your Internship package.

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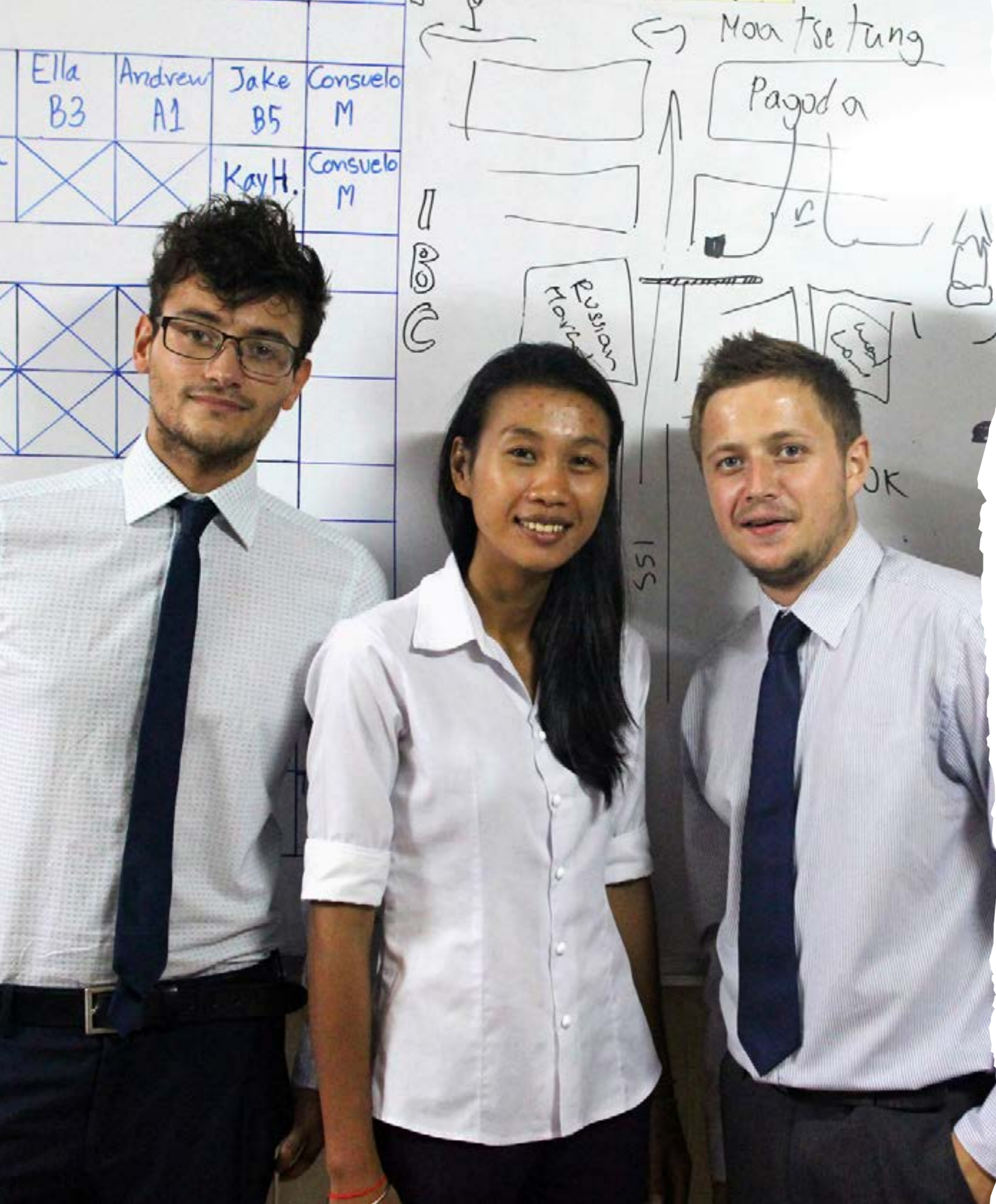

# WHAT'S THE COST?

## This covers:

## Other costs

### FLIGHTS:

- These aren't included in the price so you'll need to cover return flights to Phnom Penh International Airport (PNH) yourself.

### VISA:

- This costs approx. £25/\$35 and although we can help you organise it, you'll need to factor this into your budget.

### POLICE CHECK:

- You'll need a police check from whichever country you live in. Contact your local police department to find an exact cost for your trip.

### BUDGET OF £30/€50 PER MONTH:

- You'll need this to cover meals that aren't included, as well as spending money whilst you're out there.

### TRAVEL INSURANCE:

- You'll need to arrange cover for your whole trip.

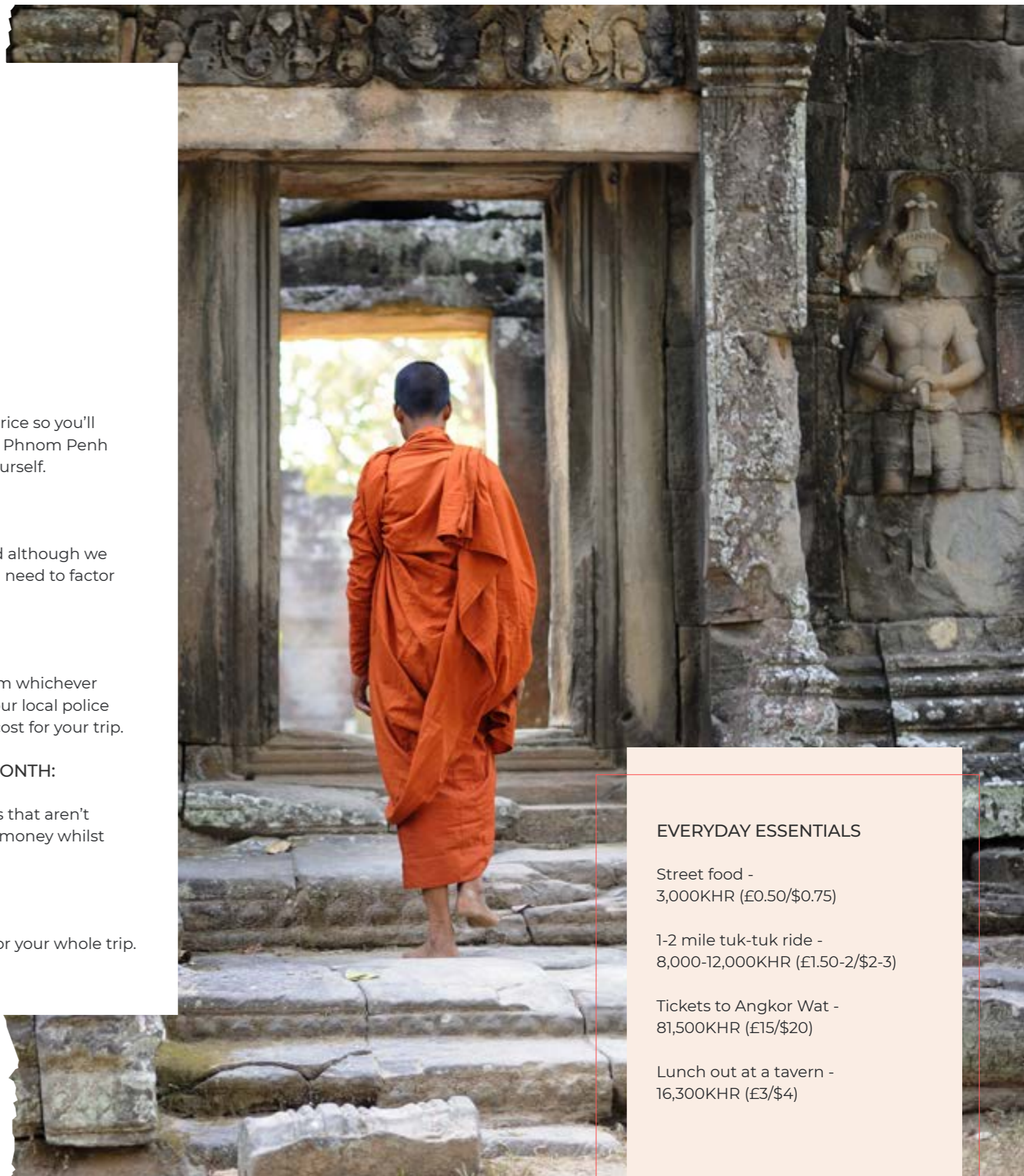

# FREQUENTLY ASKED Questions

## Q: DO I NEED TO BE ABLE TO SPEAK KHMER (CAMBODIAN)?

Nope! Feel free to learn the basics before you go but you won't be expected to speak to your students in anything other than English!

## Q: WHAT AGE STUDENTS WILL I BE TEACHING?

Your students will be between 3-18 years old because it depends on the school you are placed at.

## Q: WILL I NEED TRAVEL INSURANCE?

Yes! You'll need to arrange travel insurance to cover the entire length of your trip. This is at your own cost and needs to be arranged in advance of travelling.

## Q: WILL I HAVE A POINT OF CONTACT AT THE SCHOOL TO GO TO IF THERE ARE ANY PROBLEMS?

Yes, you'll be assigned a mentor at your school who is there to assist you in both academic and personal matters so you're never alone!

## Q: HOW MANY HOURS WILL I BE TEACHING EACH WEEK?

You'll be working roughly 35 hours per week with 2-4 hours per day in the classroom. The rest of your time will be filled with lesson planning, creating fun resources and attending teachers' meetings.

## Q: WHAT WILL MY ACCOMMODATION BE LIKE?

During your Internship, you'll be staying on the school campus in accommodation provided by the school. You'll be placed with at least one other intern so there's plenty of opportunity to socialise and get to know your local community!

## Q: WHAT VISA DO I NEED?

To teach and travel in Cambodia for 3 months, you'll need to have a business visa. Our in-country partners will write to you with a business visa invitation letter and you'll need to take this with you on your flight and produce it at the immigration desk on arrival into Cambodia (cost US\$35).

## Q: CAN I GET A DISCOUNT IF I'VE ALREADY GOT A TEFL QUALIFICATION?
